

INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE BOND TRANSPARENCY ACT OF 2017

Election on November 3, 2026:

PROPOSITION

Shall the City of Moore, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the amount of Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000) to provide funds for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, improving or repairing streets, bridges and drainage improvements in said City, to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of 7 per centum per annum, payable semiannually and to become due serially within 20 years from their date.

Section 2. The specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid street or bridge bonds shall be expended, and the dollar amounts for each such project shall be as follows:

Project 1. Engineering and design expenditures and construction of drainage improvements at N.E. 20th Street and Lincoln Avenue, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and utility line replacement	\$7,700,000
Project 2. Engineering and design expenditures and resurfacing of Ramblin Oaks Drive between N.E. 4th Street and S.E. 1 st Street and on Main Street from Ramblin Oaks Drive east approximately 500 feet, and construction of drainage improvements on Ramblin Oaks Drive, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and utility line replacement	\$8,800,000
Project 3. Engineering and design expenditures and construction of drainage improvements on Sooner Drive, including necessary curb and guttering, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, streetscape and utility line replacement	\$1,500,000

Authorized the City to issue \$25,100,000 in general obligation bonds for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and equipping various parks and recreational facilities within the City.

Shall the City of Moore, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the amount of Six Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,700,000) to provide funds for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, improving or repairing streets or bridges in said City, to be owned exclusively by said City, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of 7 per centum per annum, payable semiannually and to become due serially within 20 years from their date

Section 2. The specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid street or bridge bonds shall be expended, and the dollar amounts for each such project shall be as follows:
