### **Public Hearing for a Substantial Amendment to the 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan and Citizen Participation Plan**

The City of Moore has been allocated Community Development Block Grant COVID-19 (CDBG-CV) Funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The CDBG-CV funds have been appropriated by *The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), 2020 (Pub. L. 116-136)*. CDBG-CV funds are to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19. On April 2, 2020, the Department of Housing and Urban Development allocated Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$200,472 to the City of Moore in order to assist in the prevention, preparation for, and response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The City proposes an amendment to its 2019 CDBG Action Plan to include the allocation of the CDBG-CV funds.

In order to expedite the availability of these funds, the City of Moore is proposing an amendment regarding the comment period and reasonable notice section of its Citizen Participation Plan.
